Within just a few years, Urban Handyman Inc. grew from a startup into a recognized business, leading Nick to become the Head Contractor for Season 1 of W Network's hit series *Love It or List It Vancouver*, which aired on HGTV in the United States as *Love It or List It Too*. Nick has also shared his construction expertise through projects including CBC's *Weather Gone Wild Home Audit*.
